

MATERIALS









GLUE GUN OR TAPE

SCISSORS

GLUE STICK







ARCADE CABINET INSTRUCTIONS


STEP ONE

Print template at full size (8.5"x11") and attach to cardboard sheets. A glue stick can help with this.






Glue the sides to the back of the cabinet and fold in where indicated.



STEP THREE


Fold the front of the cabinet. Glue the triangular tabs to the bottom of the control panel for support.

Note: In the end, the template will be on the inside of your cabinet, so you can fully customize the outside!




STEP FOUR


Secure the front to the sides with glue on the side tabs. The control panel will sit on top of the sides for extra support.




STEP FIVE

Insert the screen and secure it with the tab on the control panel.




